Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollars, in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the said party of the second part forever released and discharged therefrom, have remise, released, sold, conveyed and quit-claimed, and by these presents do remise, release, sell, convey and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand, which the said party of the first part have in and to the following described lots, pieces or parcels of land, to wit: Commencing Nineteen Rods and Six Links North of the South East corner of the North East quarter of Section No Ten running thence West One Hundred and Sixty Rods thence North Thirty Six Rods and Six Links thence thence East One Hundred and Sixty Rods thence South Thirty Six Rods and Six Links to the place of beginning
Also commencing Seventy three Rods and Fifteen Links North of the South East corner of the North East quarter of Section No Ten, running thence West One Hundred and Sixty Rods thence North Thirty Seven Rods and Eight Links thence East One Hundred and Sixty Rods thence South Thirty Seven Rods and Eight Links to the place of beginning. All being in Township Fourteen North Range Three East of the fourth principal Meridian.
